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1.0 Introduction

The following represents Cenovus Energy's Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Benefits Report for the quarter ending September 30, 2022 as required under the conditions set out in Decision 2001.01 for the White Rose Development Project.

This report provides a summary of activities related to Cenovus' Atlantic Region operations (White Rose and West White Rose) and also includes activities of its major subcontractors.

2.0 White Rose Project Employment Summary

In Q3 2022, a total of 741 people were employed on Cenovus' White Rose operations, of which 306 were located offshore. The total number includes people employed with Cenovus and its contractors and includes North Amethyst and South White Rose Extension (SWRX). The offshore number for this reporting period includes personnel from *SeaRose FPSO*, support vessels, helicopters and tankers.

Of the total personnel, 680, or 92%, were residents of Newfoundland and Labrador when hired, while another 36, or 5%, were residents of other regions of Canada at the time of hire. The number of women employed on White Rose operations was 152, or approximately 20%, of the total workforce (Table 2.1).

Employment for the West White Rose Project is reported separately in Section 3.0.

3.0 West White Rose Project Employment Summary

As of September 30, 2022, 636 people were reported employed on Cenovus' West White Rose Project (WWRP), representing more than 362,000 person hours for the quarter. Of those hours, 169,757 occurred in Newfoundland and Labrador (Table 3.1). The number of women employed on the WWRP was 79, or approximately 12% of the total workforce (Table 3.2).

On May 31, 2022, Cenovus and its partners announced the restart of the West White Rose Project. Activity across the project team continued to ramp up modestly in Q3.

3.1 Targets for Women

In Q3 2022, the total WWRP workforce was 636. The total number of people employed in each category is used to calculate the percentage of women employed in the category against the target. This information is shown in Table 3.4. Specifically,

- Management and Professionals 91 (29 women)
- Engineers –45 (7 women)
- Technicians and technologists 60 (7 women)
- Skilled trades 401 (24 women)
- Other field services 32 (5 women)

Table 3.5 outlines the percentage of women working on the WWRP as of September 30, 2022 against the targets in the project Diversity Plan.

4.1 Expenditure Analysis

Table 4.1 below summarizes the Q3 2022 data contained in the individual reports for the following work scopes: White Rose Project, North Amethyst Project, Exploration, West White Rose Pilot, South White Rose Extension, and West White Rose Project. The combined spend for Q3 2022 was approximately \$123.3 million, with a content breakdown of 38.5% Newfoundland & Labrador, 17.2% Other Canadian, and 44.2% Foreign Content. The increase in Foreign Content in Q3 can be linked to a large payment made to a single Original Equipment Manufacturer.

Overall, the combined total-to-date spend is approximately \$15.6 billion, with a content breakdown of 51.8% Newfoundland & Labrador, 20.9% Other Canadian, and 27.4% Foreign (Table 4.2).

5.0 Purchase Order Summary

In Q3 2022, 1,011 purchase orders, valued at approximately \$53.3 million, were issued for the White Rose and the West White Rose Project. Table 5.1 provides a summary by location.
